

What users have to say about the ALOKA Alpha 6

I think the new ultrasound machine from ALOKA meets all demands, which a sonographer expects from a modern ultrasound device. The optical design is very attractive as there is a big flat screen which enables a good view. The device is on the other side very compact, so that there is not much space required and it is very easy to move it, if necessary.

The handling is very user friendly and easily to remember as buttons and functions are arranged in a logical way. The resolution and picture quality are amazing due to "harmonic tissue" function and can be changed in different ways as needed for different scan requirements. The Doppler is very sensitive and completely adequate for routine scans.

In a test phase I have scanned a patient with postmenopausal bleeding, who was thought to have endometrial hyperplasia on a previous scan. However, the scan on the ALOKA Alpha 6 revealed an endometrial polyp, which could be clearly identified. The diagnosis was confirmed on histology after hysteroscopy and polypectomy. Another patient was thought to have an imminent abortion. Scanning the patient with the ALOKA Alpha 6 showed unfortunately a tubal ectopic pregnancy with an embryo of 2mm and positive cardiac activity.

Based on my experience I can recommend the ALOKA Alpha 6 as an excellent ultrasound device with high resolution, perfect picture quality, an excellent Doppler and a very easy and user friendly handling. I think this ultrasound device fits perfect to outpatient clinics and private practice, where routine scans are frequently done. I also think that due to the user friendly handling it might be also for young and not so experienced doctors an excellent device.
